WHAT IS 'HOME'?

In their new walkabout installation, they immerse themselves into the multicoloured shades of a notion that means something different to everyone, bringing to light the important link between home and humanity – HOM[E]ANITY.

HOM[E]ANITY is an interactive exhibition where performative and participatory elements fuse with music and photography while secret soundscapes fill the space with the voices of young people telling their connection with and experience of 'home'. The audience is invited to join this exploration with all their senses.
